The Point In Time Count (PIT) is a census of literally homeless persons and families, meaning the count only includes individuals and families who live in a place not meant for human habitation (including the streets or in their car), emergency shelter, transitional housing, and hotels paid for by a government or charitable organization on the night of 1/22/2024.

*This count only includes those who consented to completing an assessment with our surveyors.

The PIT report includes survey data from the following counties: **Leon, Gadsden, Franklin, Wakulla, Jefferson, Liberty, Madison and Taylor**. *Note- Persons in a specific county be represented in the HMIS data collection if they were in but there were in an emergency shelter, however, those individuals may not have surveyed by a volunteer during the count.*
