The Point In Time Count (PIT) is a census of literally homeless persons and families, meaning the count only includes individuals and families who live in a place not meant for human habitation (including the streets or in their car), emergency shelter, transitional housing, and hotels paid for by a government or charitable organization on the night of 1/27/2025. \*This count only includes those who consented to completing an assessment with our surveyors.

The PIT report includes survey data from the following counties: Leon, Gadsden, Franklin, Wakulla, Jefferson, Liberty, Madison and Taylor.

The overall decrease in reported homelessness this year is largely attributed to a combination of reduced HMIS participation by some providers and lower-than-usual bed utilization on the night of the count. These factors impact the completeness of the data and do not necessarily reflect a decline in community need.
